The prophet Isaiah son of Amoz came and said to him, "This is what the LORD says: 'Put your affairs in order, for you are about to die; you will not recover.' " <sup>2</sup> Then Hezekiah turned his face to the wall and prayed to the LORD, <sup>3</sup> "Please LORD, remember how I have walked before You faithfully and wholeheartedly and have done what is good in Your sight." And Hezekiah wept bitterly. (2 Kings 20:1-3)
